


IWH Study Helping Us Better Understand Cannabis Use in Canadian Workplaces

The Institute for Work and Health is leading a study looking at cannabis use in Canadian workplaces from 2018-2021. The first pre-legalization survey found that 24% of people using cannabis in BC and Ontario reported using cannabis before or at work. 


