- needs to place an order for CCDC/CCA Documents. They purchased 100 CCDC 9 seals, 1 CCDC 2 registration number, 10 CCDC 2 seals, and 20 CCDC 11 seals. Member cost for this order was \$365 vs non-member cost of \$590, saving \$225
- attended annual Christmas Food Drive Lunch; 5 member employees registered, saving \$100
- advertises yearly in the NCA Trade Directory. One 1/4-page ad saves ABC Construction \$100 annually.
- referred a member to the NCA; saved \$100 on their renewal fee

ABC Construction's annual NCA membership fees are \$997; their above savings are significant with their NCA membership. (\$1845-\$997=\$848)
