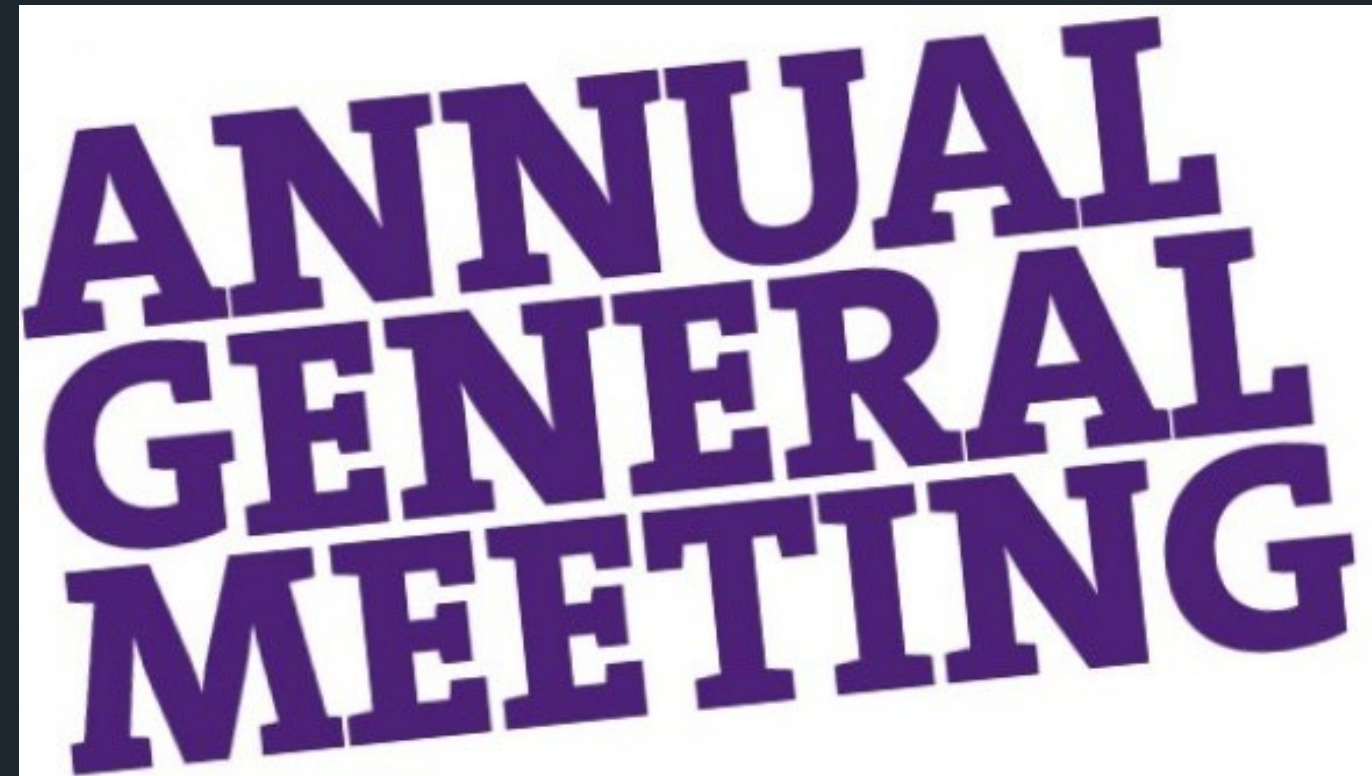

- attended annual Christmas Food Drive Lunch; 5 member employees registered, saving \$100
